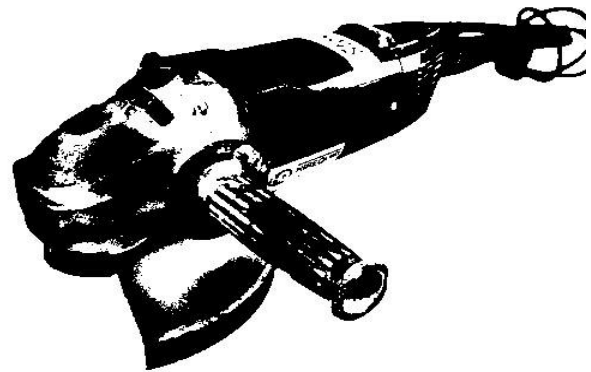

Pre Start Checks and Safety

- ! Ensure the machine has a current Electrical Code of Compliance
- ! Have correct grinder and accessories for job
- ! Accessory is firmly secured
- ! Have correct spanners to change accessory
- ! Ensure all guards are in place
- ! Do not use in wet areas or conditions
- ! Do not change blades with power connected
- ! Ensure it is the right blade for the job and that it is fitted correctly
- ! Keep the worksite clear of debris and people
- ! Always use a residual current device (RCD) or transformer
- ! Do not use in flammable or explosive areas
- ! Do not use broken or damaged blades
- ! Do not carry the tool by the cord
- ! Do not attempt unqualified repairs
- ! Take care around electric cables, gas lines, etc
- ! Ensure you have no loose clothing and long hair is tied up
- ! Use appropriate breathing filters when working with cement fibre sheets

When Operating

- Always hold machine firmly with both hands
- Trigger may be locked by depressing lock button (on some models)

Starting procedure

- Plug machine into power source
- Depress safety switch and
- Pull trigger

Stopping and After Use

- Release trigger
- Turn off at power supply
- Unplug lead
